The Stafford Diagnostic Scale for Tongue Tie and Lip Tie

Ankyloglossia (Tongue-Tie) Classification



Type 1

- •Tip of tongue attaches directly to floor of mouth via lingual frenulum
- Commonly requires frenectomy to improve range of motion for nursing, speech, etc.



Type 2

- Distal to tip of tongue with significant restriction of movement
- Often creates cupping or scooping of tongue



Type 3

- Attachment distal to mid-tongue
- May appear within normal limits
- Corrected to improve breastfeeding



Type 4

- Posterior Tongue Tie
- Difficult to diagnose
- Corrected to improve breastfeeding
